### THE SENTIDINO STORY

Sentidino is a Galician word that means to do things calmly and think every step through. It was a word that Galicians have always used ("do things with Sentidino"). This label represents a seafaring boat associated with the fisherman who bravely go to work on the sea and have to work with "Sentidino" to return home safely.

The vines are trellised in a unique pergola system that allows the grape bunches to hang down under the canopy 6ft from the Earth to avoid humidity and rot. Primary soils of the region are mineral deposits of granite and schist with pockets of alluvial and colluvial soils.

### WINERY DETAILS

Myriam Vazquez has been the Owner of Vinos Bodegas Gallegas since 2002. Under her direction, she hired Olga Verde, a young native oenologist from Galicia to make the wines in 2020. Olga started making wine in Chile and New Zealand before returning to her native land in Rias Baixas to make Sentidino.
